Description	<p>Tumulus at Little Shelford. Seven pots, one ivory `wristlet', and specimens of samian and blackware (Roman?) found in red hill, Foulness. Finds of Roman urns in 1949 reported.</p> <p>In 1848 Stephen Allen of Rayleigh Lodge, levelling a `barrow' on Loading Marsh in Little Shelford, found in its centre a large urn containing burnt bones and 7 or 8 pots grouped round it, of which two were apparently Samian". Finds are reported to have been made in a red hill between the house and sea wall and comprised a large grey urn, two smaller vessels, two samian vessels and two fragments of samian, the vessels dating to the C2-C4 AD.</p> <p>Several Romano-British burials found in the mid C19 and 15 more containing 14 vessels found in 1972;nearby occupation site (11220)</p> <p>Photos of the excavation and some of the vessels and pottery in SMR</p> <p>Site of tumulus marked on OS map, 1:25000</p> <p>Other ref</p> <p>Finds in Prittlewell Priory Mus.</p>
